
the problem

- Competence can't be seen
- we need workplace-based assessments (for the „Does“ level on Miller's Pyramid)
- busy clinical environment
- nobody likes extra administrative work
- not clear on which clinical situations which WBAs can be done



the problem

- WBAs are not done
- Feedback conversations don't happen
- Training is less efficient
- Patient safety might be at stake



the solution

~~the problem~~

- Create an intuitive mobile application (www.prepared.app)
- Include **ALL** possible professional tasks as EPAs (about 100)
- Choose training institutions to participate (e.g. USZ, LUKS, KSW, HVS, KSB)
- Voluntary participation by trainees and supervisors (no instructions, no faculty development)

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

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the solution

~~the problem~~

- 2800 WBAs in 18 months (most of them at USZ)
- 20 WBAs per trainee (between 0 and more than 100pa)
- 1-5min per WBA (depending on amount of feedback)
- High or very high usability
- Increased feedback quality
