<b>Promotion of postgraduate training in line with the activities of the SIWF</b> The current focus of the SIWF's/ ISFM's activities is on the following topics: Competency- Based Medical Education (CBME), Entrustable Professional Activities (EPA), Faculty Devel- opment, Planetary Health, training in outpatient settings, continuity between undergraduate and postgraduate training, and the " <u>General objectives</u> ". Submissions on other topics are possible, provided that the relevance for postgraduate training is justified. In all projects, it should be explained whether or how the trainees' perspective is taken into account.	1	
<b>Relevance for postgraduate training in Switzerland</b> The project idea either represents an innovation or solves a problem. The problem statement must base on (Swiss) data and the international literature. Didactic projects and research projects must be relevant to medical training in Switzerland.	2	
Clearly formulated project goal / clearly formulated research question The goal/research question is formulated concisely and comprehensively.	1	
Appropriate methodology The planned (didactic) methods are appropriate for the project goal / research question.	1
